Entry Form Instructions

- You must fill in every space applicable; you may fill out a printed hard copy hand written PDF or the preferred way submit a Google form at <https://forms.gle/v7nnYbBXGuXmFKTb9>
- Once all is filled in, scan or take picture with phone of necessary pages of entry form and email to AkronSummitHolocaustEducation@gmail.com with "entry" along with "your name" in the subject line or mail to Jewish Community Board of Akron, Atte: Akron-Summit Holocaust Contest, 750 White Pond Dr., Akron, OH 44320 or drop off on February 4th from 11:00am to 6:00pm at the Summit County Executive's Office, Ohio Building 8th Floor, 175 S. Writing Entry Instructions

- Email writing entries to AkronSummitHolocaustEducation@gmail.com as a word document with your name in the subject or email Google doc link with access granted or fill out Google Form at <https://forms.gle/v7nnYbBXGuXmFKTb9>
 - Word documents can be created in Google Docs by selecting file-download as-word document; attach in email
- Word count should be 1000 words or less for writing piece (does not include cover page or citation page)
- Writing entrants do not need to fill in the artists statement; you only need to submit page one of Entry Form
- Must submit a citation page of all sources used for the entry (to be included at the end of your writing piece)
- Must submit a cover page (to be included at the beginning of your writing piece) (do NOT include name or school)
- Individual entry only
- Number all pages and double space

Visual Art Instructions

- Entry must be delivered between 11am and 6:00pm February 4th, 2022 at **Ohio Building, 175 S. Main St., Akron- 8th floor** or other arrangements made before February 4th, 2022
- Dimensions (of all pieces) must be no more than 24"x24" for 2D and combined total (l x w x h) less than 60" for 3D
- Fill out artist statement on page 2 of entry form or in Google Form in less than 100 words
- A hard copy of page 2 of entry form or a copy of artist statement must be turned in when art is dropped off
- Collaborative entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form for each of the collaborating artists (only one artist statement needs to be submitted per group)
- Include a citation page of all/any sources used to create your art including citing any images used, no format necessary
- Do **NOT** write name on front of art piece
